Register for courses	Depends on your field of study: starting approx. September, often ending mid-/end September. Research as early as possible when the course registration in your field of study opens!	→ <u>"Course selection/Learning Agree-</u> ment"	
• OPTIONAL: Sign up for sport courses at the University Sports Institute (USI)	USI offers sport courses at reasonable prices. Sign up from approx. mid-September	\rightarrow "Services of the University"	
(recommended) Arrival in Vienna	approx. mid-/end-September, earlier if attending a preparatory German course	→ <u>"Orientation"</u>	
Register with the Municipal District Office	within 3 days of arrival	\rightarrow "Entry into Austria / visa"	
Participate in an "Orientation" session	Depends on the chosen date (between beginning of September and beginning of October). Register online after receiving an invitation e-mail.	→ <u>"Orientation"</u>	
• OPTIONAL: Get in touch with Team Barrierefrei ("accessible studying")	as soon as possible after nomination, before the start of the semester	\rightarrow "Services of the University"
