

SUPPLEMENT for Learning Agreements ERASMUS Incomings

- 1. The University of Vienna as the receiving institution confirms that the educational components listed in the Learning Agreement are in line with its preliminary course catalogue as is currently available on the internet (i.e. in the semester preceding the start of the Erasmus stay of the incoming students).
- 2. It needs to be highlighted that the course catalogue is subject to change until one month before the beginning of each academic year/semester.
- 3. As the course catalogue will only be final one month before the beginning of each academic year/semester, the University of Vienna does not request the signature of the Learning Agreement by incoming students on beforehand. There are consequently no time limits in this respect on the part of the University of Vienna.
- 4. The receiving institution is not obliged to communicate any problems regarding the proposed programme in the Learning Agreement, responsible persons and/or study period.
- 5. One month before the semester starts, incoming students are requested to inform themselves about registration criteria and prerequisites for attending of particular courses they want to follow. This information is available in the online course catalogue. It varies from course to course. The Learning Agreement does not replace the course registrations and the prerequisites for attending.
- 6. Courses will be eligible for the student as far as they are in conformity with the attached "Information for Incoming Erasmus Students".
- 7. It is important that incoming students are present in the first week of each semester in order to finally decide upon the courses they want to follow. They are invited to meet the Erasmus coordinators and their staff for this purpose. This occasion is the most meaningful point in time to sign the Learning Agreement.
- 8. Generally, presence in the first class of each course is mandatory for participation, which generally take place in the second week of each semester.
